Creating a Game Plan

On Friday, April 21, a group of interested construction helpers came to John "Boy's" house in Osburn to make an agenda for completing its renovation in July.

A short list includes:

- Install house numbers.
- Install smoke detectors in the bedroom and living room.
- Install carbon monoxide detectors, also.
- Insure we have a working bathroom with a door.
- Insure that all systems in the kitchen are working.
- Install GFI outlets in the kitchen, bathroom, and laundry room.
- Run the electrical line to the garage.
- Have the electrical system inspected.
- Have the gas line inspected with connections to the new furnace, etc.
- Install adequate windows to meet the code.
- Install the front door donated by Shoshone Glass.
- Fix the insulation and wallboard around the windows.
- Repair any holes in the wallboard after the electrical system is approved.
- Finish the flooring.
- Finish installing insulation and sheetrock in the laundry room
- Install adequate insulation in the attic
- Install heater vent covers in ceilings for furnace duct work.
- Scrape or sand interior walls & paint.
- Repair rotted exterior board in outer walls, scrape and paint.
- *Say a prayer that this will all come to be on time.*
